Dr. Wyman is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Family and Community Medicine at the University of Toronto and Associate Medical Director of the Substance Use Service at Women's College Hospital in Toronto as well as Medical Educator with META:PHI. As a physician working in primary care and addictions, in community and academic settings, her interest is in improving care pathways for people with substance use disorders through education, resource development and advocacy across the health care sectors.

Objectives:

- Review the evidence for buprenorphine relative to other opioids as a treatment for chronic pain and opioid use disorder
- Explore strategies for using microdosing to initiate buprenorphine
- Identify current gaps in knowledge with respect to long-term use of buprenorphine in the older population
