Effects of Medical and Non Medical Cannabis Use in Older Adults: A Scoping Review

Speakers - Dr. Corace and Dr. Hutton

Dr. Kim Corace is the Vice-President of Innovation & Transformation at The Royal Ottawa Mental Health Centre, an Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry at University of Ottawa, a Clinical Investigator with the Institute of Mental Health Research, and a Clinical Health Psychologist, and a Presidential Officer of the Canadian Psychological Association (CPA). Her work focuses on improving treatment access for people with substance use and mental health comorbidities. She contributes her expertise to numerous committees and initiatives to improve mental health and addictions care.

Dr. Hutton is a Senior Scientist with the OHRI's Clinical Epidemiology Program, Director of the Knowledge Synthesis Unit, an Associate Professor within the University of Ottawa's Faculty of Epidemiology and Community Medicine and Adjunct Scientist with the Royal Ottawa Mental Health Center. He is a leader in the OHRI's CIHR-funded knowledge synthesis group which conducts research projects and other work for the Drug Safety and Effectiveness Network. His research includes oncology, transfusion medicine, infectious diseases, mental health, addiction medicine and more.
