

- client seen in his./her home, LTC facility or hospital
- initial assessment by a case manager +/- psychiatrist depending on need
- not for crisis intervention

- -offers specialized geriatric assessment and treatment for seniors with complex health needs
- cognitive changes that are unexplained, unclear etiology, unmanaged behaviour or functional issues
- depression with additional medical problems
- history of falls
- polypharmacy
- safety concerns
- clients seen by a multidisciplinary team in his/her home or through videoconference at WPSHC.
