



Always include sexual orientation, gender identity, and/or gender expression in conversations about advanced care planning with 2SLGBTQI+ Seniors. This might include asking them about members of their chosen family, the name and pronouns they use, and decisions related to their appearance (e.g., clothing, grooming, makeup routines). When a 2SLGBTQI+ senior is experiencing memory loss or cognitive impairment, it is critical that you respect, uphold, and honour these considerations.
